Department of Education and Training policy requires specific authority, in writing, before school personnel can give any medication to a child.

PLEASE NOTE:

The medication must be in a clearly marked and appropriate container. Any medication specifically prescribed for that child by a doctor can be given by the designated representative. The label must show the child's name, the dosage direction and the doctor's name. **The medication must be in a pill, capsule or liquid form**, or in the case of ASTHMA preventative medication, in appropriate "puffer" form. A request for any other medication to be administered must be in writing clearly marked with the child's name and the dosage direction.

Should a spoon or medicine glass be required, the parent must provide same.
